



Recommended vaccination schedule for kittens:

FVRCP #1 in series @ 8 weeks of age

FVRCP #2 and FeLV #1 in series @ 12 weeks of age

FVRCP #3 and FeLV #2 in series @ 16 weeks of age

Adult cats should get FVRCP one year after kitten series and then every 3 years **OR** annually as recommended by your doctor.

* Ask about adding Feline Leukemia to your kittens vaccination schedule!

We recommend fecal exams at every visit, deworming and flea/ear mite treatment, monthly flea/tick prevention, and microchipping.

Rabies can be given any time after 12 weeks of age. First vaccine is valid for one year, no matter the patients age. Then, repeated every 3 years after that. **It is Washington State law that all domesticated animals are vaccinated against rabies. (cats, dogs & ferrets)**
