

#### LVT Program

The Licensed Veterinary Technician Apprenticeship is a paid 3-year program that blends 6,000 hours of on-the-job training with 766 hours of classroom instruction.

Gaining demanding skills and knowledge while working at Cascade Veterinary Clinics aids to address the shortage of veterinary technicians and provides opportunities for employees facing financial, educational, geographical, or socio-economic barriers to attend LVT school.

The LVT Apprenticeship Program is open to individuals 18 years or older, with High School Diploma or General Equivilancy.

The LVT Program is completed upon passing the Veterinary Technician National Exam (VTNE) for licensure.
